Gentlemen,

Sorry for my late response to this email as I was out of state on depositions the majority of last week.

Just to echo the previous responses, the transfer of ownership of both Appalachian Waste Control and Thelma Waste Control have been completed. The details are as follows:

1. As to Thelma Waste Control, the deed transferring all real property was fully executed on September 10, 2013 as was the instrument transferring all other assets. The Kentucky Division of Water approved the transfer on September 27, 2013.
2. As to Appalachian Waste Control, the deed transferring all real property was fully executed on September 26, 2013 as was the instrument transferring all other assets. The Kentucky Division of Water approved the transfer on October 21, 2013.

I trust all of the responses coupled with the details in the same are sufficient notice to comply with the PSC's order and allow the matter to be fully closed.
