



the Commission's regulations and recommended that corrective actions be taken by Big Sandy. A copy of the report was mailed to Big Sandy and a response with regard to the recommended corrective actions was requested by April 30, 1985. Big Sandy did not respond as requested and has not responded to the staff's follow-up letters dated April 24, 1985, and June 10, 1985.

After considering the matter and being advised, the Commission, on its own motion, finds that a hearing should be held in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Big Sandy shall appear at a hearing at the offices of the Commission in Frankfort, Kentucky, October 31, 1985, at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Hearing Room No. 1, and show cause, if any it can, as to why it should not comply with the Commission's regulations: Pressure, Section 6 of 807 KAR 5:066; Minimum Pipe Size, Section 11 of 807 KAR 5:066; Service Interruptions, Section 5(5) of 807 KAR 5:066; Customer Complaints, Section 8 of 807 KAR 5:066; Pressure Testing Device, Section 6(3) of 807 KAR 5:066; System Maps and Records, Section 17 of 807 KAR 5:066; Posting Tariffs, Regulations, and Statutes, Section 11 of 807 KAR 5:011; Meter Testing, Section 17(1) of 807 KAR 5:066; and Water Supply Measurement, Section 7(1) of 807 KAR 5:066.
