

I am writing concerning the rate increase requested by Kentucky Power. I live in Eastern Kentucky and most people here are on fixed incomes. We cannot ask for rates increases on our pensions, social security, SST, etc. when our expenses are more than our incomes. I think a typical increase of \$31 a month is a very big jump in price. Half that amount would be too large for most people here. My pension was set on my retirement date and will not increase in my lifetime. I understand expenses for Kentucky Power increase also but we should not be given this large a burden.
