Special Rules:

(a) The consumer shall install and operate in regular use a standard approved storage type of electric water heater subject to automatic control and shall have no non-electric household water heating device in use during any part of the year (such as heating coils in a fuel burning range or furnaces).

(b) The rated capacity of any motor served under this schedule shall not exceed ten horsepower.

(c) Provisions shall be made in the consumer's water heater wiring installation for an automatic control device which the cooperative may install at its discretion.

(d) The standard approved type of water heater shall consist of an insulated tank of 30 or more gallons capacity, which has two thermostatically controlled, non-inductive heating elements of not less than 20 watts per gallon of tank capacity in the lower element and 30 watts per gallon of tank capacity in the upper element. The thermostats shall be so arranged to allow only one element to operate at a time. The lower element shall be placed to heat the whole tank and the upper element to heat only the upper part of the tank. The entire installation shall be subject to the approval of the cooperative including the wiring, tank size, tank installation and capacity in watts of the heating elements.

(e) The lower element shall be arranged for control by a device which shall be set so that the lower element may operate not more than 18 hours per day and be automatically disconnected during the remaining hours. The hours of disconnection shall be determined from time to time and shall be the hours of system peak load. The upper element shall not be controlled.

(f) Consumers desiring uncontrolled water heating service may secure such service under the schedule applicable for other types of usages, in which case no control device will be required.

The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.	
<u>Power Factor:</u>	
The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Power factor may be measured at any time. Should any measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 85% the demand for billing

purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 85% and divided by the percent power factor.

Minimum Monthly Charge:

The minimum monthly charge under the rates in this schedule shall be \$3.00 where 5 kva of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 5 kva of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by .75% for each additional kva or fraction thereof required. Where it is necessary to extend or re-enforce existing distributing facilities, the minimum monthly charge may be increased to assure adequate compensation for the added facilities. Where the minimum charge is increased in accordance with the terms of this section, additional energy and demand shall be included in accordance with the foregoing rate schedule.

Minimum Charge for Seasonal Service:

Consumers requiring service during not to exceed nine months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of twelve times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Delayed Payment Charge:

In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the date of the bill, five percent (5%) will be added to the bill.

Special Rules:

(a) Temporary Service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of materials returned to stock. A deposit in advance may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

(b) Service at Primary Voltage. If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the demand and energy charges, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, service may be metered at secondary voltage and adjusted to primary metering by adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatt demand.

(c) Consumers having their homes on the premises with their business establishments may include service for both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under this schedule using the rate set out in this schedule. If the consumer prefers he may make provisions for two meters, in which case his usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule and rate, and his usage for business purposes will be billed under this schedule and rate.

(d) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.

Special Rules:

(a) Service under this schedule is available to consumers who occupy residences which are so located that the premises can be served from the main distribution lines of the cooperative at an estimated expenditure of not more than \$100.00 per consumer. This estimate shall include the entire cost of extending service including the cost of meters, service lines and transformer, or pro rata share of transformer cost where other consumers are served from the same transformer. Service will be furnished under this schedule for lighting and household and farm appliances; all subject to established rules and regulations of the cooperative covering this service.

(b) Service is available to the above classification of consumers either under Schedule D or under Schedule A, Farm and Home Service. Any consumer served under Schedule D may at any time, upon giving notice to the cooperative, change to Schedule A but after such change, may not change to Schedule D again until a period of twelve months has elapsed.

In case a meter is installed for each establishment the rate set forth in Schedule A shall apply to each establishment except that in case of each tenant house the first 40 kwh used per month shall be billed at the rate of 8.75¢ per kwh.

The minimum monthly charge shall be \$3.00 for the main farm house and \$1.50 for each of the tenant houses, but the sum of the minimum monthly charges shall not be less than the charge corresponding to the required transformer capacity as set forth under "Minimum Monthly Charge" of Schedule A.

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
