COMMERCIAL, SMALL POWER, AND THREE-PHASE FARM SERVICE

Availability

Available to commercial, small power, and three phase farm customers of the Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation located on its lines for service including lighting, incidental appliances, cooking, heating, and motors, all subject to the established rules and regulations of the Corporation covering this service. Single-phase customers having their homes on the same premises may include farm and home service on the same meter.

Service under this schedule is limited to customers whose load requirements do not exceed 50 KW. Service under this schedule is not available to seasonal customers unless otherwise provided for. Those with electric heat will have the option of service under Schedule 10.

Rate

First	25 kilowatt hours or less per month	\$ 2.50
Next	55 kilowatt hours per month	5.0¢ each
Next	1920 kilowatt hours per month	2.0¢ each
Over	2000 kilowatt hours per month	1.7¢ each

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.50 or the amount provided in the contract for service, whichever shall be higher. The minimum charge shall entitle the consumer in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding to the minimum charge.

Type of Service

Single-phase, and three-phase where available, at available voltage.

Conditions of Service

Single-phase power service is limited to motors not in excess of ten horsepower.

Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower must be three-phase. In those cases where additional investment is required for three-phase service, it will be rendered only after the following conditions are met: The customer will give satisfactory assurance by means of a written agreement as to the character, amount and duration of the business offered and make such guarantees or deposits as may be required under the Cooperative's Policies.

Terms of Payment

Payment is due within 10 days from the date of the bill.

WATER PUMPING SERVICE

Availability

Available for water pumping service in areas served by Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation. The customer shall have the option of service under this schedule or any other standard rate schedule. The customer, having selected one schedule, will continue to be billed under such schedule for not less than 12 consecutive months unless there should be a material and permanent change in the customers use of service.

Conditions

The service hereunder is conditioned upon the customer operating pumping loads at hours other than at those at which the company's system peak load occurs at all times except in case of emergencies. Service hours and other operating problems to be agreed upon by contract.

Rate

1.8¢	Per KWH for the first 10,000 KWH used per month
1.6¢	Per KWH for the next 40,000 KWH used per month
1.3¢	Per KWH for all over 50,000 KWH used per month

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question.

- (1) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.
- (2) A charge of \$0.75 per KVA of installed transformer capacity.
- (3) A charge of \$25.00.

Fuel Cost Adjustment Charge

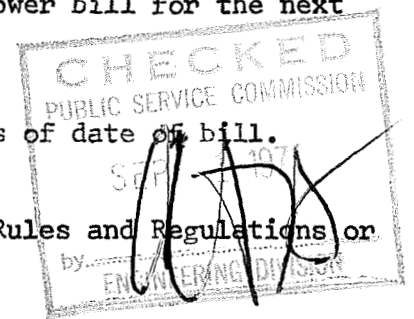
In case the rate under which seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with a fuel cost adjustment provision in Seller's wholesale power contract the foregoing energy charges shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the fuel cost adjustment per KWH in Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

PUBLIC BUILDING LIGHTING AND POWER SERVICE (CON'T)

Power Factor Adjustment

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for consumers with 50 KW or more of measured demand to correct for average power factor lower than 90% and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$3.00 where 3 KVA or less transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity the minimum monthly charge shall be increased by 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Where it is necessary to extend or re-enforce existing distribution facilities, the minimum monthly charge may be increased to assure adequate compensation for the added facilities. Where the minimum charge is increased in accordance with the terms of this section, additional energy and demand shall be included in accordance with the foregoing rate schedule.

Minimum Annual Charge for Seasonal Service

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding 9 months per year may guarantee a minimum annual payment of 12 times the minimum monthly charge determined in accordance with the foregoing section, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge.

Temporary Service

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service less the value of materials returned to stock. A deposit in advance may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill for service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.

Service at Primary Voltage

If service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of 10% shall apply to the demand and energy charges, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of 10% shall also apply to the minimum charge. However, service may be metered at secondary voltage and adjusted to primary metering by adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt-hours and kilowatt demand.

Terms of Payment

The above rates are net, and bills are due within 10 days from the date of the bill.

1.2¢ per KWHR.

Minimum Charge

The minimum annual charge will be not less than \$9.00 per KVA of required transformer capacity as determined by the Cooperative.

Term of Contract

Service under this rate schedule will be furnished under an "Agreement for Purchase of Power" for a term of not less than five (5) years.

Special Terms and Conditions

Consumer shall furnish the Cooperative information necessary to permit the Cooperative to determine and install the necessary transformer capacity to adequately service the load under maximum operating conditions.

After that the consumer will be required to pay for the cost of replacement.

The lighting equipment shall remain the property of the Cooperative. The consumer shall protect the lighting equipment from deliberate damage.

The consumer shall allow authorized representatives of the Cooperative to enter upon the consumer's premises and to trim trees and shrubs as necessary for maintenance of the lighting equipment and for removal of lighting equipment upon termination of service under this schedule.

The Cooperative and the consumer shall execute an agreement for service under this schedule for a period of not less than one year.

Terms of Payment

The customer's bill will be due at the same time as his bill for metered service.
