NOTICE OF SATISFACTION

On January 28, 2005, Richard Lewis Hamilton (“Mr. Hamilton”) filed a formal complaint against Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) alleging that he did not bear financial responsibility for the replacement of a wooden pole. On February 4, 2005, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) entered an Order directing KU to satisfy the matters complained of or file a written answer to the complaint.


KU, by counsel and in compliance with the Commission's February 4, 2005 Order to Satisfy or Answer, hereby notifies the Commission that it has satisfied Mr. Hamilton's complaint by taking the following steps:

1. KU reviewed the facts with Bell South Telecommunications and will collect the charges from Bell South;
2. KU waives the charge of \$932.32 as billed to Mr. Hamilton; and
3. KU informed Mr. Hamilton of this occurrence in a letter dated February 11, 2005.

WHEREFORE, in light of this satisfaction, Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully requests the Commission to dismiss the complaint with prejudice and close this matter on its docket.
