In a review of materials previously filed in this Case, North Central Telephone ("NCTC") realized that a handful of references in its narrative did not correlate to the "Plans and Spec" Exhibit ("Exhibit") included in the application. The material contained in the Exhibit is correct.

- The Original filing (paragraph 5) read, "NCTC will deploy 53 miles of FTTH plant."

This sentence should read "NCTC will deploy 74 miles of FTTH plant including 53 route miles and 21 miles of drops."

- That same paragraph read, "The initial cost of the FTTH plant is \$1,639,000. End user electronic equipment for each premise converted will be approximately \$168,950, inclusive of labor."

Those sentences are revised to tie with the Exhibit to read, "The initial cost of the FTTH plant is \$1,553,145. End user electronic equipment for each premise converted will be approximately \$202,410, inclusive of labor."
