O R D E R

On January 27, 1987, Bluegrass Cellular, Inc., filed an application for Commission approval of certain retail rates to provide cellular mobile telephone service. Bluegrass Cellular stated it would initially be providing service under a reseller agreement with Bell South, but would construct its own facilities at a later date.

The Commission finds that its approval of the proposed retail rates is not needed because it exerts regulatory jurisdiction only over the wholesale rates of cellular mobile telephone service. Bluegrass Cellular, Inc., must obtain Commission approval prior to any construction of facilities and for any wholesale rates.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that based on the findings set out herein, this case shall be and it hereby is dismissed.
