O R D E R

On March 3, 1987, US Sprint ("Sprint") filed a tariff revision proposing to rename its existing WATS products and make minor technical corrections; to change the method by which customers' WATS bills are calculated and to introduce UltraWATS and Travelcard services. On April 6, 1987, the Commission suspended the tariff in order to allow sufficient time for investigation.

On April 10, 1987, the Commission granted interim approval of the proposed tariff pending the further investigations and made the tariff subject to certain stipulations that were described in the Interim Order.

On June 29, 1987, Sprint filed another tariff with the Commission wherein it proposed to introduce two new services, Direct 800 and ULTRA 800.

The Commission is of the opinion that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs.

The Commission is also of the opinion that because of the similarity of the filing made on June 29, 1987, to the previous filing made on March 3, 1987, they should be consolidated into this instant case. The style of this instant should be altered to read as follows:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The tariff filing for Direct 800 and ULTRA 800 Service be and hereby are consolidated into this instant case.

2. The style of this instant case shall be altered to read as mentioned previously in this Order.

3. The proposed tariff for Direct 800 and ULTRA 800 service be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date of September 1, 1987. The pages of the tariff hereby suspended are:
